1. BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES: CONSIERATION/APPROVAL

Dixon requested approval of the December 5, 2023 Minutes.

County Commissioner, Gary Heberling gave his monthly report.

- On January 10th, the State of Michigan is offering a webinar on the New Solar Energy Program.
- There has been confusion on the State ORV ordinance. Per M-DOT, the current State ORV ordinance does not allow an ORV to be ridden on any State M Road such as M-46 or M-19. The Sanilac County ORV Ordinance allows an ORV to be ridden on county paved roads to the nearest side road.
- Some constituents have stated complaints about farm equipment tearing up roads, large equipment causing excessive dust, young children driving large equipment, etc. The Right to Farm Act of 1991 has been discussed and farmers have the right to farm. Mr. Heberling would like to see a meeting between the stakeholders in order to come up with a reasonable solution.

4. NEW BUSINESS

- a) AARP Grant Fund Planning: Consideration/Approval
 - 1. Townley Engineering RFP Geo-location and inventory of sanitary sewer.
 - Dixon reported that the proposal from Townley Engineering, LLC for the GPS Geo-location and inventory project has been received. The project is to be paid from the ARPA Grant Funds received by the Township. The proposal stops short of a video inspection and cleaning of the underground assets. However, Mr. Dixon recommends this as the first step in geo-location and inventory of assets. The quote is for \$5,750.

b) Poverty Guidelines

- Dixon presented the updated 2024 Poverty Guidelines. Assessor, Jeannie Diaz, stated that this year low income landowners are allowed to request a 100%, 75%, 50% or 25% reduction in property taxes.
